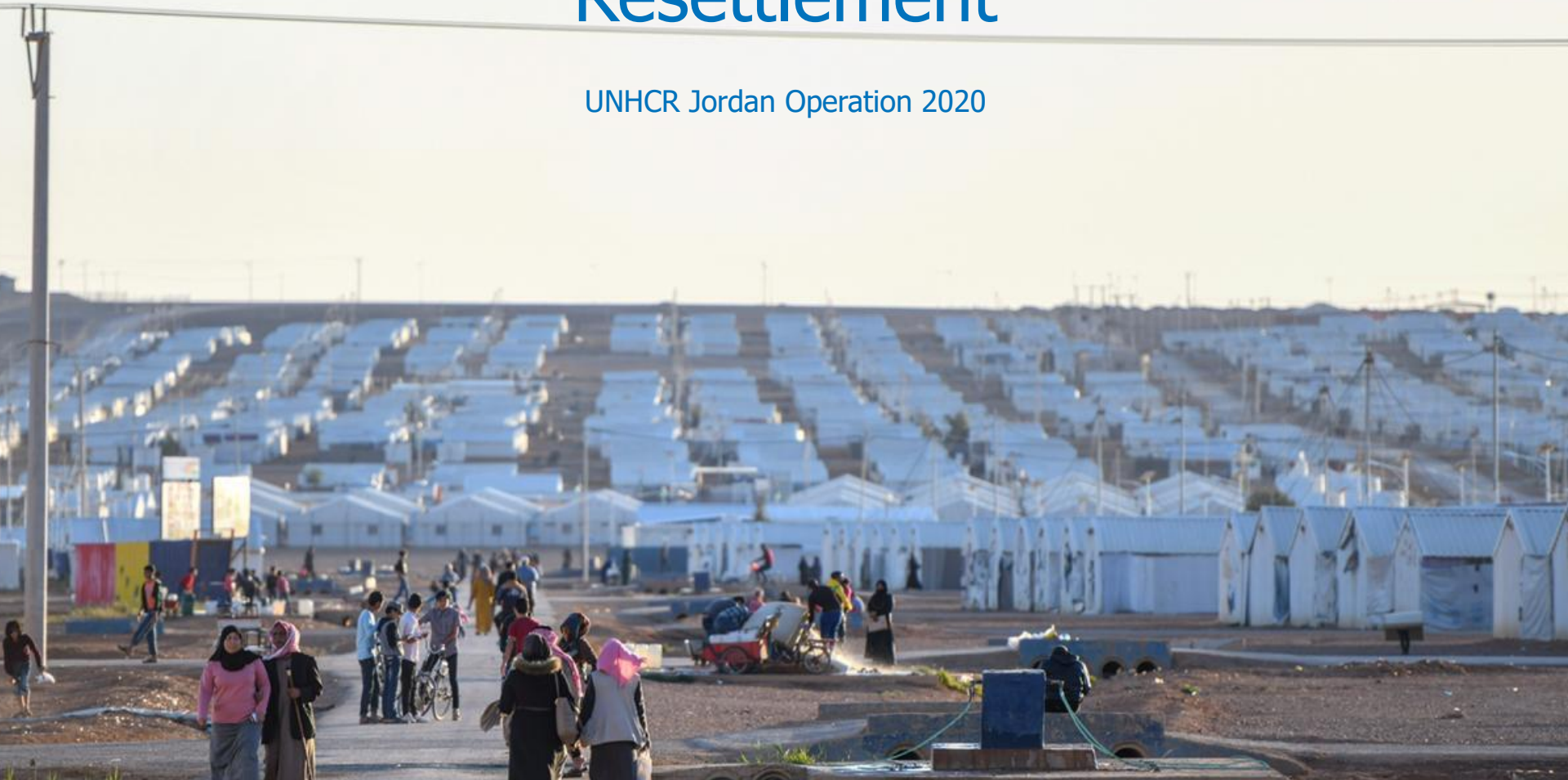

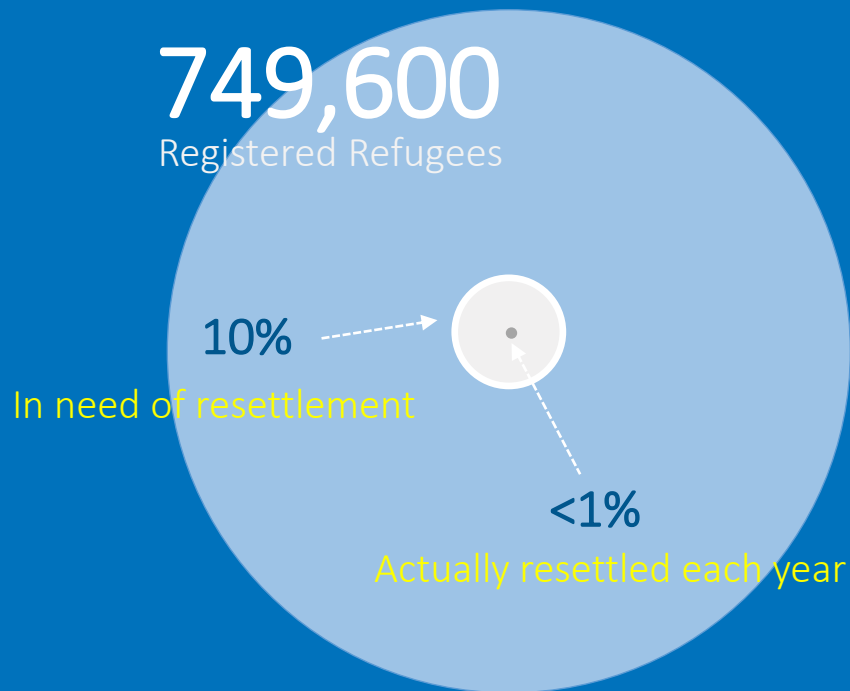

Refugee Population and Resettlement Needs Jordan

September 2020

- Countries of Origin:
 - Syria 88%
 - Iraq 9%
 - Yemen 2%
 - Sudan 1%
- 83% of refugees in urban locations
Amman, Mafrak and Irbid
- 17% of refugees in camps
Zaatari, Azraq, and Emirati camp
- 5,500 resettlement target
Canada, France, Germany, Italy, Ireland,
Norway, Sweden, UK



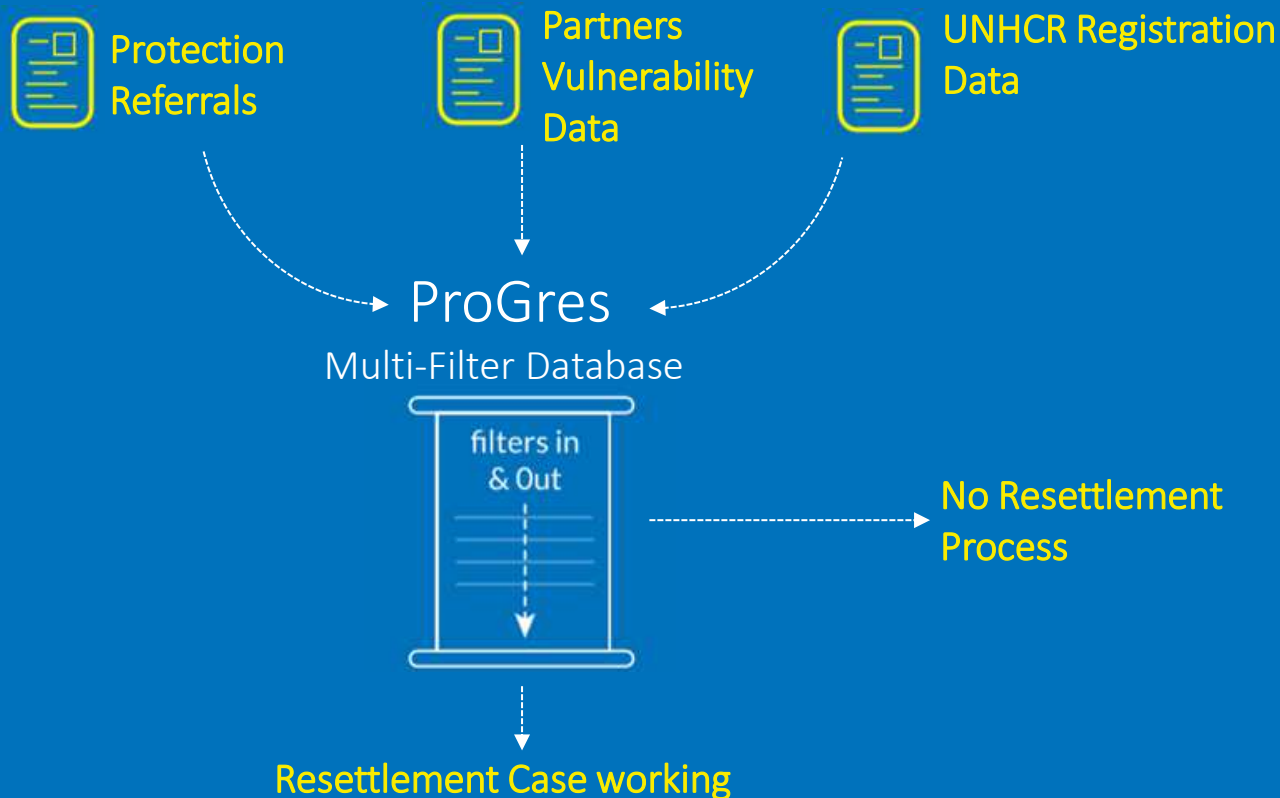
Resettlement Needs and Profiles in Jordan

UNHCR BO Amman

- **Access to work:** pre COVID 72% rely on debt for daily subsistence, high rates of illegal work.
- **Access to health:** 70% of refugees can not afford drs or medication.
- **Women, children, and adolescents at risk:** children out of school/working, risk of underage marriage.
- **SGBV/LGBTI:** both in country of origin and country of asylum.
- **Survivors of Violence and/or Torture:** following events in country of origin.

Response to COVID 19

UNHCR BO Amman

- **Health:** preventative and response health measures in place in camps
- **Emergency cash assistance:** over 57,000 vulnerable refugee families in urgent need due to COVID-19
- **Communication with Communities:** info on preparedness and services, two-way comms, SMS, WhatsApp groups, refugee volunteers, social media and protection helplines
- **Education:** support for refugee students to access e-learning platforms
- **Remote Resettlement Processing:** phone and video interviews to maintain submissions, and utilize every opportunity, facilitating resettlement travel.
